LAUNCH OF ALT SISTER NGO

In 2010 Andrew Lees Trust realised its long term strategy with the launch of **Andry Lalana Tohana**, an independently registered and managed Malagasy NGO.



Andry Lalana Tohana Madagascar (ALT Mg) is made up of core members of the Malagasy team who have benefited from ten years of working under the auspices of Andrew Lees Trust (ALT UK). They have significant field and managerial experience working with and reporting to a range of high ranking donors including the EC, UN agencies, DFID, and USAID. The results achieved have demonstrated they possess the professional capacity that makes them a leading force in the development sector in southern Madagascar.

AIMS

Andry Lalana Tohana aims to reduce the effects of poverty and enable local populations to prepare themselves for natural disasters, increase their food security, and improve capacity for protecting the environment and managing natural resources more sustainably. It also aims to help promote the community's needs.

ALT Mg commits itself to undertaking all the measures necessary for the accomplishment of these objectives, and adopts an ethical stance in the execution of its duties.

NEW BEGINNINGS

Andry Lalana Tohana is an independent Ngo with its own management, Board, strategy and resources – including assets transferred from ALT UK. Since 2009 it began its own funded development programme including:

PARECAM/AROPA (IFAD/EC)

- sorghum reintroduction - Bekily
- Oct 09 – March 2011
- Extend campaign into 10 new communes – until June 2011

UNICEF PEAER Sanitation Programme

- set up 73 radio listening groups with 876 members in Anosy and Androy
- re-activate 25 radio listening groups
- Oct 09 – April 2010

UNFPA/CNLS

- health education to 8 communes of Betroka
- Using a mobile cinema to educate villagers in 32 sites across 9 communes
- August – Nov 2010- pilot



WORLD FOOD PROGRAMME/(MAE Norway)

- Build 100 fuel efficient stoves in 35 school canteens in Androy
- May-July 2010 – pilot
- Build 1596 fuel efficient stoves in school canteens, 6 regions of Androy, Anosy
- February-July 2011

FAO

- Seed production for emergency food security assistance
- Sept 2010 – April 2011

ALT UK/BALCOMBE TRUST

- Deliver emergency relief programme in drought areas of Androy
- April 2010-March 2012

Additionally, ALT Mg is in receipt of two regional production units (RPU) from ALT Projet Radio. They continue to develop rural radio programming for development ([see also project radio](#)) and have proposals submitted to expand the radio work.

TREE NURSERY



The ALT tree nursery has been transferred to ALT Mg management. The nursery has been distributing trees and training to local people for planting and tree care techniques since 2003. It is currently providing filao seedlings to stabilise dunes in the deep-south ([see ALT Emergency Relief](#)) and fruit trees to local families, schools and associations
